I shall announce the winner at our AGM on Friday 26 January. A prize awaits...

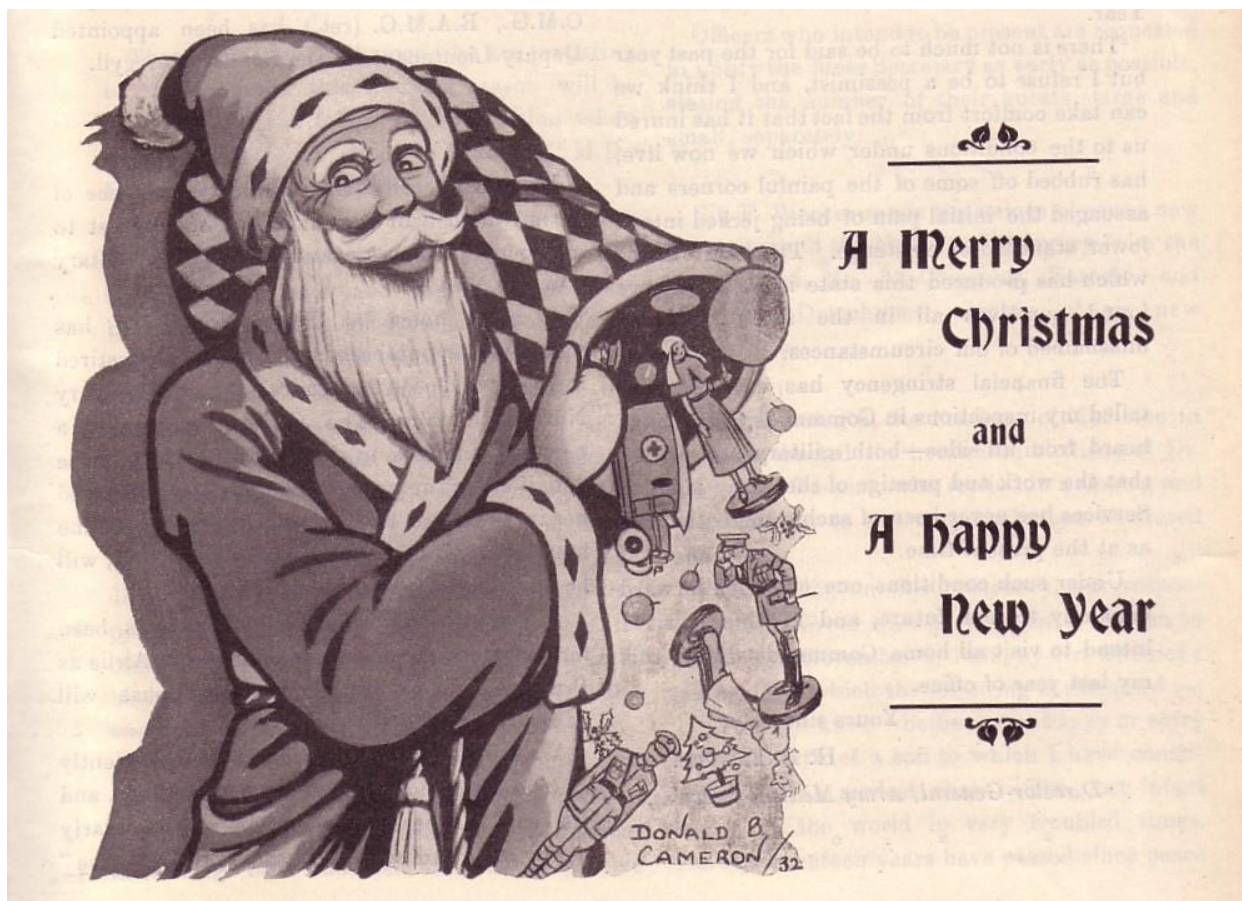

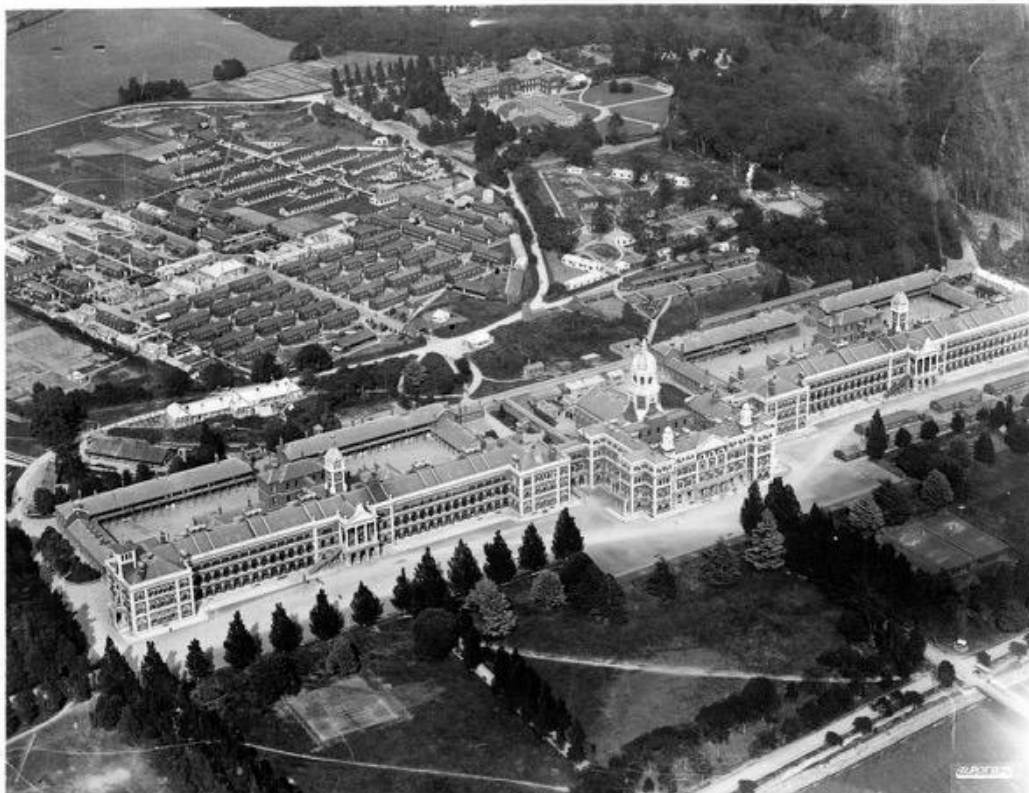

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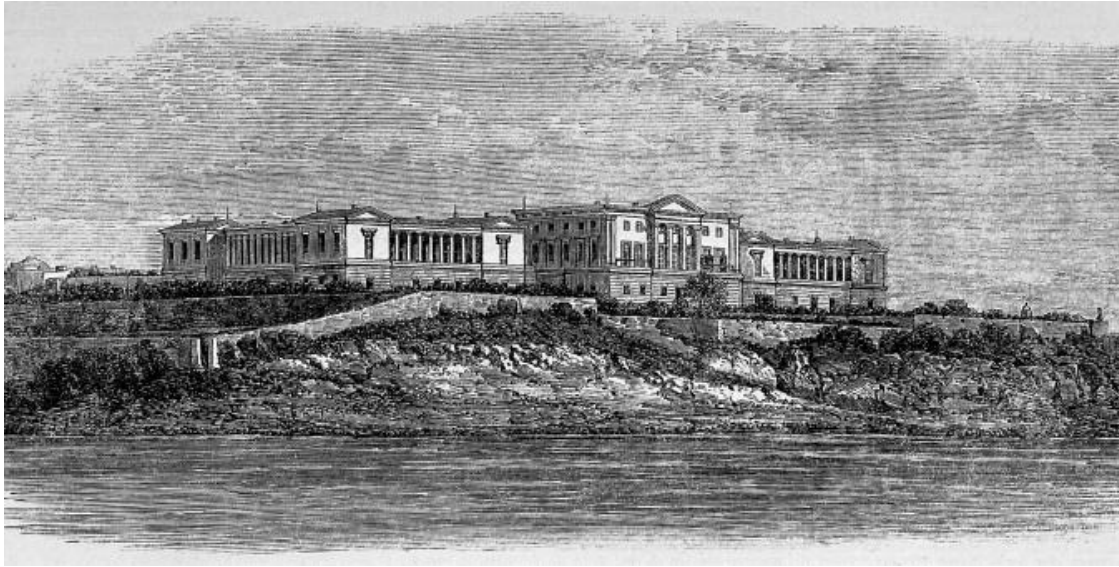

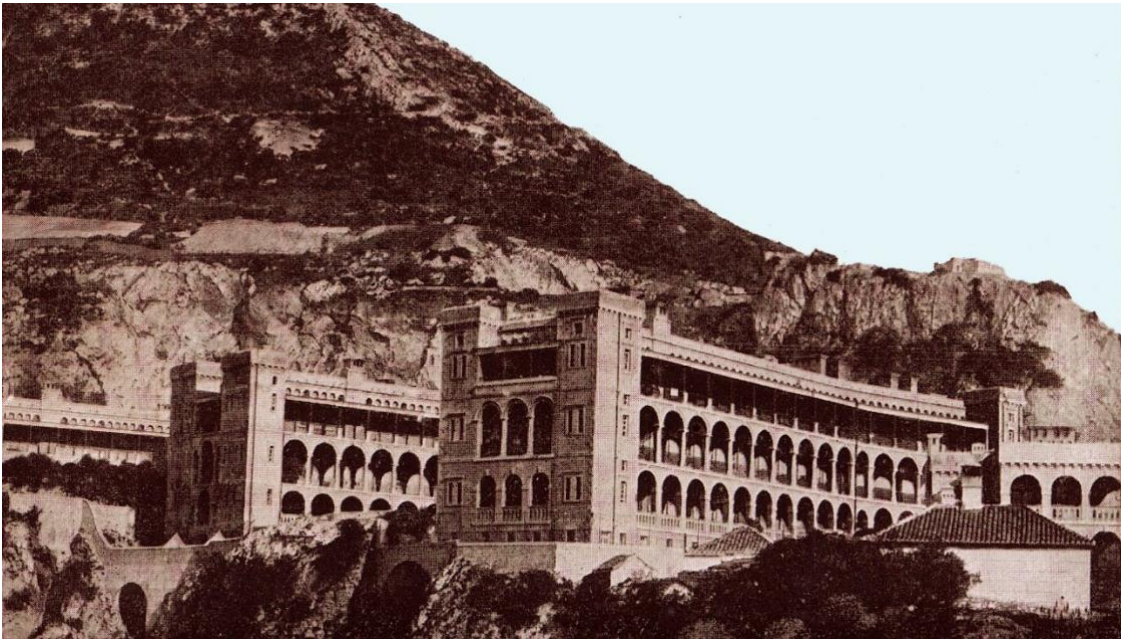

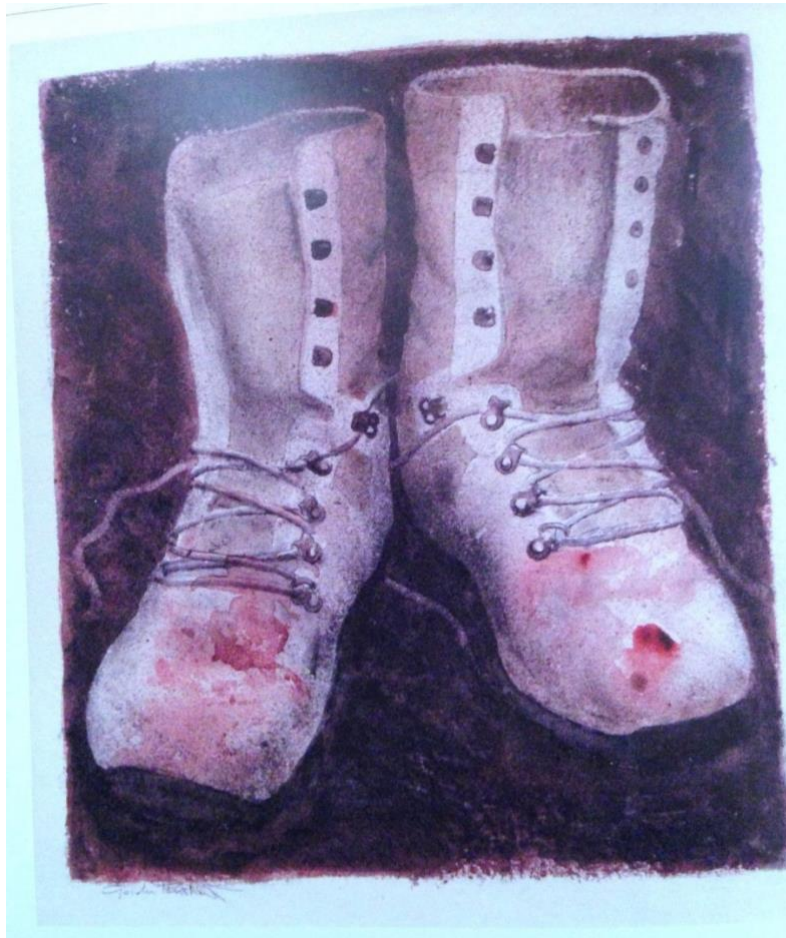
