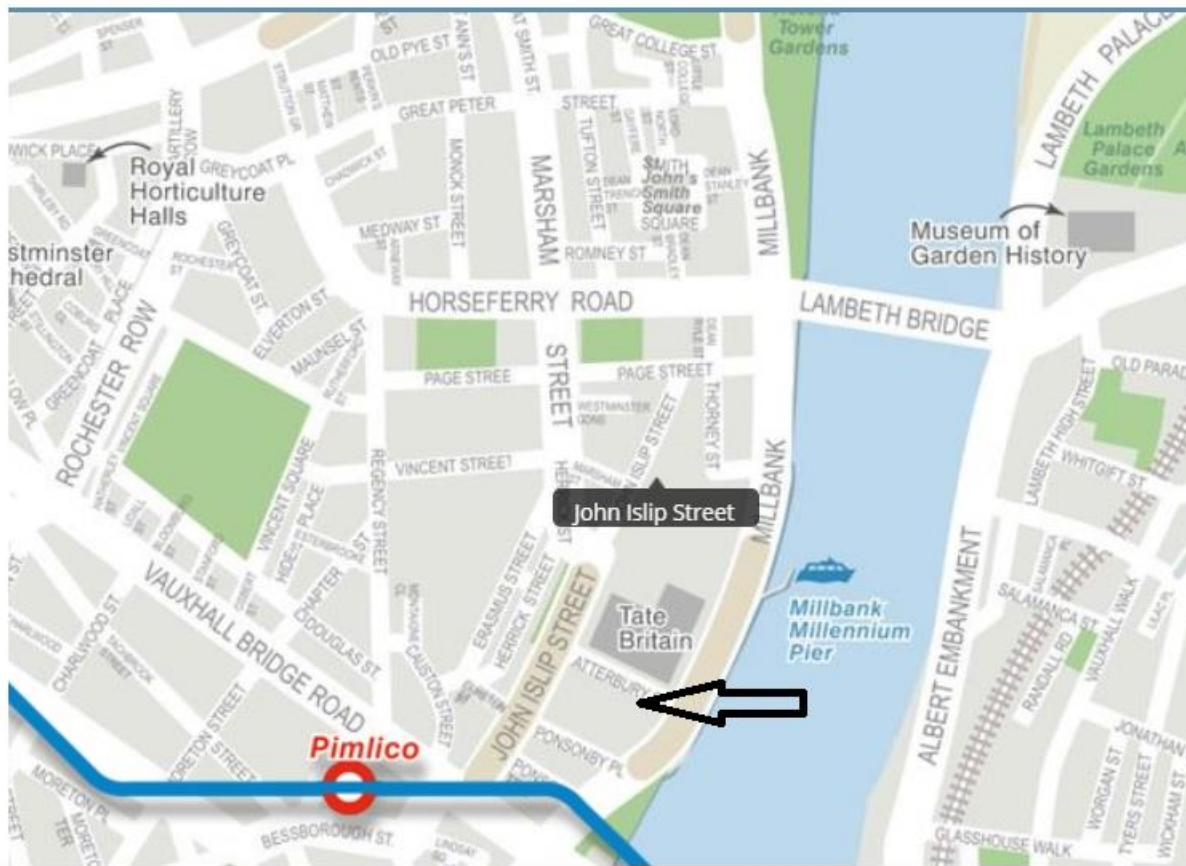
## Directions for Millbank (Chelsea College of Arts, formerly the Royal Army Medical College)
